



Charter for the Central Texas Regional Chapter of the Army Strategist Association (ASA)


As of: FEB 2021

1. The Central Texas Regional Chapter of the ASA is a community of Army Strategists dedicated to the practice of Strategic Art. This chapter includes (but is not limited to) Army Strategists currently serving at US Army North/5th Army, US Army South/6th Army, US Army Futures Command, and III Corps who are collectively interested in professional growth and in building comradery.
2. The Central Texas Regional Chapter is an out-growth and subsidiary of the national (Army-wide) ASA organization, which is a 501(C)(3) non-profit organization based in Washington DC that operates to advance four basic goals: strengthen the community of strategists, enhance the study and practice of strategic art, recognize the contributions and achievements of those in the community, and revitalize and make the association relevant.
3. The Central Texas Regional Chapter will undertake activities to include:
 - a. Discussions on strategic topics and best practices
 - b. Host events with guest speakers
 - c. Staff Rides
 - d. In-person and virtual social gatherings
 - e. Participation in the ASA Mentorship Program
4. Central Texas Chapter will serve the community of local strategists. This includes all current and former FA59s, CP60s, and ASA Members. Other interested individuals in the Central Texas community who are engaged in the study and practice of strategic art are welcome to participate as invited guests.
5. The position of President and Vice President are both elected positions and those elected should be able to carry out a two year term. Elections will be held annually between 1 August and 30 September or as needed to fill a vacant office. All current Central Texas Chapter members will be allowed to nominate and vote for the positions of President and Vice President.
6. The President of the Central Texas Regional Chapter executes the following duties:
 - a. Establishes the vision and priorities related to Chapter activities and services.
 - b. Liaises with the President of the National ASA organization.
 - c. Appoints officers to administer chapter functions such as Membership Director, Social Director, Event Coordinator, Treasurer, and others as required.

7. The Vice President of the Central Texas Regional Chapter executes the following duties:
 - a. Oversees the functions of membership and financial transactions to include those executed by additional Chapter officers.
 - b. Appoints and coordinates with Area Representatives such as San Antonio, Austin, and Fort Hood.
 - c. Fills in for the President during absences.

8. This Charter may be amended at the discretion of the Chapter President, provided that the amended Central Texas Charter is transmitted to the National ASA Board of Directors for filing in official Association records.
